Membership is open to all who have served in the Royal Air Force, on Marine Craft, in any of the recognised Marine Branch Trades. The Club also accepts as Members, certain types who, whilst not strictly in this category, have such a close association with the "webfoot clan" that they may be considered almost "webfooted".

The Annual Subscription is £10.00 per year (1st September to 31st August). We no longer offer Life Membership. Annual subscriptions can be paid for any number of years in advance but unfortunately we do not offer a discount.

The Club came into being as the result of suggestions from several former MBCs and was founded at a meeting at the Victory Club in London on 23rd October 1951. At that meeting, a committee was elected and the principle aims of the Club determined. It was felt that many friendships made during "Service" days should be kept alive and the spirit, unique to A.S.R. and The Marine Craft Section, was worth preserving. The Committee does all it can to carry out these aims by organising reunions, etc., generally keeping members in touch and endeavouring to contact all "ex-types".. The Club has an active membership of 700 and an Annual Reunion is held each year. The Club is recognised officially by the Ministry of Defence (Air) and each year on Remembrance Sunday, wreaths in memory of those of our comrades who gave their lives during the Second World War, are laid at sea from Newhaven and Bridlington, also at the Cenotaph (Whitehall London) by the Club Contingent who parade there. We are also represented at the official opening of the Field of Remembrance at Westminster Abbey each November and at the Annual Commonwealth Air Forces Commemoration Service at Runnymede in May. Newsletters, giving information on the activities of the Club, news from Members and any other matters of interest are circulated to Members at regular intervals. The Club has its own distinctive pennant, tie, blazer badge, lapel badge, car windscreen sticker and wall plaque, which are for the **SOLE USE OF MEMBERS** and may be obtained through the Colours Secretary.
